2. **Supporting the Session:**

- Follow the instructions of instructors and staff to help classes run safely and smoothly.
- Encourage and support my child's efforts while respecting the role of the instructor.

3. **Punctuality:**

- Drop off and pick up my child at agreed times to ensure the smooth running of sessions.
- Communicate promptly if I am unable to meet agreed timings.

4. **Communication:**

- Respond to digital communications from SXMMA where appropriate, including updates on membership or medical declarations.

- Notify the club of any changes to my child's medical conditions, medications, or injuries.

5. **Raising Concerns:**

- Discuss any concerns or complaints directly with the Head Coach or Designated Safeguarding Lead as soon as possible, ensuring issues are addressed constructively.

6. **Safety and Welfare:**

- Promote a culture of safety and cooperation within the club environment.

- Avoid engaging in negative or disruptive behavior that may affect the club's atmosphere or the wellbeing of others.
